Applicants must have a minimum of 15 earned credits from institution(s) prior to term of admission; minimum 2.0 cumulative transfer GPA on a 4.0 scale; and eligible to return to previously attended colleges or universities. Requirements for admission to the College of Education:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 overall in accordance with ASU policy, 2.75 in professional studies listed on the ALSDE approved checklist for the program, and 2.75 in the teaching field listed on the ALSDE approved checklist for the program. ● Remedial courses may not be used to meet approved program requirements.
